## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, defining "direct contact with
- 3 children."
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6303 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 8 § 6303. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 10 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 13 "Direct contact with children." The care, supervision,
- 14 guidance or control of a child by a person, either paid or
- 15 <u>unpaid</u>, who provides child-care services.

- 17 Section 2. Section 6344(a) of Title 23, added December 19,

- 1 1990 (P.L. , No.206), is amended to read:
- 2 § 6344. Information relating to prospective child-care
- 3 personnel.
- 4 (a) Applicability. -- This section applies to all prospective
- 5 employees of child-care services, prospective foster parents,
- 6 prospective adoptive parents, prospective self-employed family
- 7 day-care providers and other persons seeking to provide child-
- 8 care services under contract with a child-care facility or
- 9 program. This section does not apply to administrative or other
- 10 support personnel unless their duties will involve direct
- 11 contact with children. This section does apply to individuals
- 12 who have direct contact with children.

- 14 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
