## AN ACT

- 1 Making appropriations to the Hahnemann University, Philadelphia. 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. (a) The sum of \$3,908,000 \$5,210,000 is hereby <—
- 5 appropriated to the Hahnemann University, Philadelphia, for the
- 6 fiscal year July 1, 1991, to June 30, 1992, for instruction in
- 7 the Doctor of Medicine program. The final payment totaling no
- 8 less than 25% of this appropriation is contingent on the
- 9 Secretary of Education certifying to the General Assembly that
- 10 the Hahnemann University has fully cooperated in the Department
- 11  $\,$  of Education's efforts to fulfill the requirements of the higher
- 12 education accountability appropriation to the Department of
- 13 Education.
- 14 (b) The sum of \$713,000 \$951,000 is hereby appropriated to <---
- 15 the Hahnemann University, Philadelphia, for the fiscal year July
- 16 1, 1991, to June 30, 1992, for the general maintenance of the

- 1 Hahnemann University, including the Allied Health, Professions
- 2 and Graduate School of the Hahnemann University, and student
- 3 aid.
- 4 Section 2. Payments to the Hahnemann University on account
- 5 of the appropriations provided in section 1 shall be made
- 6 quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the basis of costs
- 7 during the fiscal year.
- 8 Section 3. The Hahnemann University shall provide full,
- 9 complete and accurate information as may be required by the
- 10 Department of Education or the Majority Chairman or the Minority
- 11 Chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the
- 12 Majority Chairman or the Minority Chairman of the Appropriations
- 13 Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 14 Section 4. The Hahnemann University shall report its
- 15 revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements
- 16 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and
- 17 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the
- 18 "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth
- 19 of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of
- 20 Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-
- 21 Related Colleges and Universities."
- 22 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1991, or
- 23 immediately, whichever is later.
