AN ACT

1 Making appropriations to the Thomas Jefferson University,
2 Philadelphia.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. (a) The sum of ~~\$4,727,000~~ \$6,303,000 is hereby <—
6 appropriated to the Thomas Jefferson University, Philadelphia,
7 for the fiscal year July 1, 1991, to June 30, 1992, for
8 instruction in the Doctor of Medicine program. ~~The final payment~~ <—
9 ~~totaling no less than 25% of this appropriation is contingent on~~
10 ~~the Secretary of Education certifying to the General Assembly~~
11 ~~that the Thomas Jefferson University has fully cooperated in the~~
12 ~~Department of Education's efforts to fulfill the requirements of~~
13 ~~the higher education accountability appropriation to the~~
14 ~~Department of Education.~~

15 (b) The sum of ~~\$3,313,000~~ \$4,417,000 is hereby appropriated <—
16 to the Thomas Jefferson University, Philadelphia, for the fiscal
17 year July 1, 1991, to June 30, 1992, for the general maintenance

1 of the Thomas Jefferson University, including the College of
2 Allied Health Sciences, student aid and Children's Heart
3 Hospital.

4 Section 2. Payments to the Thomas Jefferson University on
5 account of the appropriations provided in section 1 shall be
6 made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the basis of
7 costs during the fiscal year.

8 Section 3. The Thomas Jefferson University shall provide
9 full, complete and accurate information as may be required by
10 the Department of Education or the Majority Chairman or the
11 Minority Chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate
12 or the Majority Chairman or the Minority Chairman of the
13 Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.

14 Section 4. The Thomas Jefferson University shall report its
15 revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements
16 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and
17 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the
18 "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth
19 of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of
20 Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-
21 Related Colleges and Universities."

22 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1991, or
23 immediately, whichever is later.
