## AN ACT

Making appropriations to the Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural School, Downingtown.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The sum of $\$ 727,000$ is hereby appropriated to the Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural School, Downingtown, for the fiscal year July 1, 1991, to June 30, 1992, for operation and maintenance of the school. The final payment totaling no less than $25 \%$ of this appropriation is contingent on the Secretary of Education certifying to the General Assembly that the Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural School has fully cooperated in the Department of Education's efforts to fulfill the requirements of the higher education accountability appropriation to the Department of Education.

Section 2. The sum of $\$ 61,000$ is hereby appropriated to the Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural School for payment of debts incurred prior to July 1, 1984.

Section 3. The sum of $\$ 41,000$ is hereby appropriated to the Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural School for special projects.

Section 4. Payments to the Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural School on account of the appropriation provided in section 1 shall be made by the Secretary of Education in equal quarterly payments.

Section 5. The Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural School shall provide full, complete and accurate information as may be required by the Department of Education or the Majority Chairman or the Minority Chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the Majority Chairman or the Minority Chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.

Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1991, or immediately, whichever is later.
