- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 2509.3 of the act of March 10, 1949
- 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
- 12 amended August 5, 1991 (P.L.219, No.25), is amended to read:

- 23 sum of one hundred twenty four dollars (\$124) for each nonpublic
- 24 school pupil transported and for the school year 1992 1993 and
- 25 each school year thereafter, each school district shall be paid
- 26 the sum of one hundred fifty nine dollars (\$159) for each
- 27 nonpublic school pupil transported.
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
