Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, providing additional grounds for refusing registration in certain cases. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1306 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 6 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: § 1306. Grounds for refusing registration. 8 9 The department shall refuse registration or renewal or 10 transfer of registration when any of the following circumstances exists: 11 12 13 (8) The department has received notice from a city of 14 the first class which has adopted a system of administrative 15 adjudication of parking violations that there are six or more unsatisfied final orders against the applicant AN APPLICANT 16

WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE CITY OF THE FIRST CLASS determining

1	liability and fixing fines for parking violations, from which	
2	all appeals have been exhausted.	
3	(i) A city of the first class shall notify the	
4	department when an THE individual has complied with all	<
5	such final orders, within ten days of compliance.	
6	(ii) When the department has refused an applicant's	
7	registration and then rescinded the refusal upon	
8	notification of the applicant's compliance with all such	
9	final orders, the department may charge the applicant a	
LO	fee determined by the department to be sufficient to	
L1	cover expenses incurred in administering this paragraph	
L2	with respect to issuance of the vehicle registration.	
L3	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
