## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 20, 1966 (3rd Sp.Sess., P.L.96, 2 No.6), entitled "An act relating to mental health and mental 3 retardation; authorizing county programs and amending, revising and changing the laws relating thereto and making an 4 5 appropriation, "further providing for the duties of the county mental health and mental retardation administrator. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 305 of the act of October 20, 1966 (3rd 9 10 Sp.Sess., P.L.96, No.6), known as the Mental Health and Mental Retardation Act of 1966, is amended by adding a clause to read: 11 Section 305. Duties of the Administrator. -- The county mental 12 health and mental retardation administrator shall have the power 13 and his duty shall be: 14 15 16 (11) To execute a release and provide the funding necessary 17 to permit a child with a mental disability or in need of a program or services for drug and alcohol abuse or dependence, 18 who resides within the county to attend a school or facility 19 outside the county when: (i) the child resides in a school 20

- 1 <u>district outside the county; and (ii) the education or treatment</u>
- 2 at the school or facility would benefit the child.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 3
