AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for payment of utility bills
- 3 by senior citizens.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 1509.1. Senior citizens.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- A public utility shall permit a senior
- 10 citizen to submit payment for a utility bill on a time schedule
- 11 coordinated with the periodic receipt of funds from Social
- 12 Security, railroad retirement, public assistance or other
- 13 similar public or private retirement or assistance program.
- 14 (b) Late payment. -- When there is a delay in the receipt of
- 15 any funds described in subsection (a), the public utility shall
- 16 not require payment of its bill until the senior citizen
- 17 <u>receives these funds.</u>

- 1 (c) Notice. -- The commission shall give a written notice to
- 2 <u>senior citizens explaining their rights under subsections (a)</u>
- 3 <u>and (b).</u>
- 4 (d) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term "senior
- 5 citizen" means a person 65 years of age or older.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
