AN ACT

1 Providing for the submission to the electors of this  
2 Commonwealth of a referendum relating to the incurring of  
3 indebtedness for construction of, and improvements to,  
4 community water and sewer systems, for maintenance and  
5 rehabilitation of State parks, historical sites and museums  
6 and for maintenance and rehabilitation of facilities at  
7 State-owned universities.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Referendum.

11 At the April 28, 1992 primary election, the question of  
12 incurring indebtedness for the purposes of the construction of,  
13 and improvements to, community water and sewer systems, the  
14 maintenance and rehabilitation of State parks, the maintenance  
15 and rehabilitation of State-owned historical sites and museums  
16 and the maintenance and rehabilitation of educational facilities  
17 at State-owned universities shall be submitted to the electors.

1 The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall certify the question to  
2 the county board of elections. The question shall be  
3 substantially in the following form:

4 Do you favor the incurring of indebtedness of no more  
5 than \$500,000,000 to be allocated for the following  
6 purposes:

7 (1) The sum of \$350,000,000 for the construction of, and  
8 improvements to, community sewer and water systems.

9 (2) The sum of \$70,000,000 for the maintenance and  
10 rehabilitation of State parks.

11 (3) The sum of \$15,000,000 for the maintenance and  
12 rehabilitation of State-owned historical sites and museums.

13 (4) The sum of \$65,000,000 for the maintenance and  
14 rehabilitation of educational facilities at State-owned  
15 universities?

16 Section 2. Conduct of election.

17 The election shall be conducted in accordance with the act of  
18 June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania  
19 Election Code.

20 Section 3. Results of election.

21 The results of the election shall be tabulated in the manner  
22 provided by law and the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall  
23 certify them to the Governor, the Senate and the House of  
24 Representatives.

25 Section 4. Allocation of indebtedness.

26 The General Assembly shall, by law, specifically allocate the  
27 proceeds of the indebtedness incurred under this act for such  
28 purposes and in such amounts as conform to the allocations  
29 specified in the referendum question.

30 Section 5. Effective date.

1       This act shall take effect immediately.
