AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, requiring certain vehicles which are required to
3 stop at railroad crossings to carry appropriate signs in the
4 rear of the vehicle.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 3342 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
9 § 3342. Vehicles required to stop at railroad crossings.

11 (e.1) Signs on vehicles.--Every vehicle, other than a
12 passenger car, which is required by this title, section or
13 department regulations to come to a stop before crossing at any
14 track or tracks of a railroad shall display on the rear of that
15 vehicle a sign, approved by the department, which states "This
16 vehicle stops at all railroad crossings."

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
