- 8 (C) ACCRUED LIABILITY CONTRIBUTION RATE. -- FOR THE FISCAL
- 9 YEAR BEGINNING [JULY 1, 1991] JULY 1, 1992, THE ACCRUED
- 10 LIABILITY CONTRIBUTION RATE SHALL BE COMPUTED AS THE RATE OF
- 11 TOTAL COMPENSATION OF ALL ACTIVE MEMBERS WHICH SHALL BE
- 12 CERTIFIED BY THE ACTUARY AS SUFFICIENT TO FUND OVER A PERIOD OF
- 13 [20 YEARS FROM JULY 1, 1991] <u>30 YEARS FROM JULY 1, 1992</u>, THE
- 14 PRESENT VALUE OF THE LIABILITIES FOR ALL PROSPECTIVE BENEFITS OF
- 15 ACTIVE MEMBERS, EXCEPT FOR THE SUPPLEMENTAL BENEFITS PROVIDED IN
- 16 SECTIONS 8348, 8348.1 AND 8348.2, IN EXCESS OF THE TOTAL ASSETS
- 17 IN THE FUND, EXCLUDING THE BALANCE IN THE ANNUITY RESERVE
- 18 ACCOUNT, AND OF THE PRESENT VALUE OF NORMAL CONTRIBUTIONS AND OF
- 19 MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS PAYABLE WITH RESPECT TO ALL ACTIVE MEMBERS
- 20 ON [JULY 1, 1991] JULY 1, 1992, DURING THE REMAINDER OF THEIR
- 21 ACTIVE SERVICE. THEREAFTER, THE AMOUNT OF EACH ANNUAL ACCRUED
- 22 LIABILITY CONTRIBUTION SHALL BE 5% GREATER THAN THE AMOUNT OF

- 4 CONTRIBUTION FOR SUCH ADDITIONAL LEGISLATIVE LIABILITIES SHALL
- 5 BE 5% GREATER THAN THE AMOUNT OF SUCH CONTRIBUTION FOR THE
- 6 PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR.
- 7 (D) SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUITY CONTRIBUTION RATE.--CONTRIBUTIONS
- 8 FROM THE COMMONWEALTH AND OTHER EMPLOYERS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE
- 9 FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUITIES PROVIDED FOR IN
- 10 SECTIONS 8348, 8348.1 AND 8348.2 SHALL BE PAID OVER A PERIOD OF
- 11 [20 YEARS FROM JULY 1, 1991] <u>30 YEARS FROM JULY 1, 1992</u>. THE

- 23 (F) FUNDING.--THE ACTUARY SHALL ANNUALLY CERTIFY THE AMOUNT
- 24 OF COMMONWEALTH APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR NEEDED
- 25 TO FUND, OVER A PERIOD OF [20 YEARS FROM JULY 1, 1991] 30 YEARS

- 10 (F) FUNDING.--THE ACTUARY SHALL ANNUALLY ESTIMATE THE AMOUNT
- 11 OF COMMONWEALTH APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR NEEDED
- 12 TO FUND, OVER A PERIOD OF [20 YEARS FROM JULY 1, 1991] 30 YEARS
- 13 FROM JULY 1, 1992, THE ADDITIONAL MONTHLY SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUITY
- 14 PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SECTION. THE BOARD SHALL SUBMIT THE
- 15 ACTUARY'S ESTIMATION TO THE SECRETARY OF THE BUDGET ON OR BEFORE
- 16 NOVEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR. IF, IN ANY YEAR AFTER 1988, THE AMOUNT
- 17 ESTIMATED IS DISAPPROVED UNDER SECTION 610 OF THE ACT OF APRIL
- 18 9, 1929 (P.L.177, NO.175), KNOWN AS THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF
- 19 1929, AS INSUFFICIENT TO MEET THE FUNDING REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
- 20 SUBSECTION OR IS NOT APPROPRIATED ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, THE
- 21 ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUITY PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SECTION
- 22 SHALL BE SUSPENDED UNTIL SUCH TIME AS AN AMOUNT CERTIFIED AND
- 23 APPROVED AS SUFFICIENT IS APPROPRIATED.

- 25 SECTION 2. SECTION 7 OF THE ACT OF JULY 9, 1981 (P.L.208,
- 26 NO.66), KNOWN AS THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT STUDY COMMISSION
- 27 ACT, SHALL NOT APPLY TO THIS ACT.
- 28 SECTION 3. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE
- 29 CONTRARY, THE PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT BOARD SHALL,
- 30 EFFECTIVE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1992, RECERTIFY

- 1 TO THE BUDGET SECRETARY, WITHIN 15 DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 2 THIS AMENDATORY ACT, THE CONTRIBUTIONS, RATES, FACTORS AND
- 3 AMOUNTS SET FORTH IN 24 PA.C.S. § 8502(K). THE BOARD'S
- 4 RECERTIFICATION SHALL REFLECT ALL CHANGES IN THE CONTRIBUTIONS,
- 5 RATES AND AMOUNTS PREVIOUSLY CERTIFIED BY THE BOARD PRIOR TO THE
- 6 DATE OF THIS ACT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1992,
- 7 REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH 24 PA.C.S. § 8328, AS AMENDED BY THIS
- 8 ACT. THE RECERTIFICATION SHALL SUPERSEDE ANY PRIOR CERTIFICATION
- 9 FOR THE YEAR FOR ALL PURPOSES.
- 10 SECTION 4. IF ENACTED AFTER JULY 1, 1992, THIS ACT SHALL BE
- 11 RETROACTIVE TO THAT DATE.
- 12 SECTION 5. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT JULY 1, 1992.
