## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 10, 1980 (P.L.1152, No.208), 2 entitled "An act establishing a county prison board for any county of the second class and providing for the powers and 3 duties thereof," further providing for the composition of the 5 board and for rules and regulations of the board. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Sections 3(b) and 5 of the act of December 10, 1980 (P.L.1152, No.208), known as the Second Class County Prison Board Act, are amended to read: 10 11 Section 3. Establishment and composition. 12 13 (b) Composition. -- The board shall be composed of: 14 (1)The county commissioners. 15 Three judges of the court of common pleas, one of (2) whom shall be the president judge, or his designee who shall 16 17 be a judge, and two judges appointed by the president judge. 18 (3) The county sheriff.

- 1 (4.1) The county clerk of courts.
- 2 (5) The mayor of any city of the second class situate
- 3 within the county.
- 4 (6) Two citizen members as provided in subsection (c).

- 6 Section 5. Rules and regulations.
- 7 The board shall, in the manner provided by law, promulgate
- 8 such rules, regulations and forms it deems necessary for the
- 9 proper administration of the board and for the operation of the
- 10 prison. The rules and regulations relating to administration and
- 11 operating procedures of the board shall provide that a majority
- 12 of the members shall constitute a quorum and that in the event
- 13 of a tie vote of the members of the board, the president of the
- 14 board shall vote a second time to constitute a quorum for the
- 15 transaction of business.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
