## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for certificates of title.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 1106(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 1106. Content and effect of certificate of title.
- 8 (a) Vehicle identification and encumbrances.--A certificate
- 9 of title shall contain such description and other evidence of
- 10 identification of the vehicle for which it is issued as the
- 11 department may deem necessary and the odometer reading, together
- 12 with a statement of any liens or encumbrances including the
- 13 names and addresses of the holder or holders of the liens or
- 14 encumbrances. The certificate of title shall also contain the
- 15 following statement if the vehicle was returned to the
- 16 manufacturer under the act of March 28, 1984 (P.L.150, No.28),

- known as the Automobile Lemon Law:
- 2 IMPORTANT: THIS VEHICLE WAS RETURNED TO THE MANUFACTURER
- 3 BECAUSE IT DID NOT CONFORM TO THE MANUFACTURER'S EXPRESS
- 4 WARRANTY AND THE NONCONFORMITY WAS NOT CURED WITHIN A
- 5 REASONABLE TIME AS PROVIDED BY PENNSYLVANIA LAW.

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
