AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 5 laws relating thereto, " providing for emergency certificates. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 8 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10 section to read: 11 Section 1215. Emergency Certificates. -- The Department of 12 Education may approve the issuance of an emergency certificate for service in public schools to a person at the request of a 13 14 public school entity upon receiving appropriate evidence of 15 exceptional conditions requiring resolution of the staffing problem, if the applicant is a graduate of a State-approved 16 teacher preparing four-year college or university and if a fully 17 qualified and properly certified applicant is not available. school district shall provide evidence to the Department of

- Education of measures taken to recruit fully qualified and 1
- 2 properly certified individuals. Such measures shall include, but
- 3 not be limited to, advertisements in newspapers and periodicals,
- including those of professional organizations and associations. 4
- 5 The emergency certificate shall be issued on the basis of terms
- and conditions agreed upon by the school district and the 6
- 7 Department of Education.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 8
