## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 24, 1941 (P.L.490, No.188), entitled
- 2 "An act relating to acknowledgments of written instruments,
- and to make uniform the law with relation thereto, "providing
- 4 for acknowledgment by attorneys.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of July 24, 1941 (P.L.490,
- 8 No.188), known as the Uniform Acknowledgment Act, amended March
- 9 15, 1951 (P.L.27, No.3), is amended to read:
- 10 Section 2. Acknowledgment within the State. -- The
- 11 acknowledgment of any instrument may be made in this State
- 12 before--
- 13 (1) A judge of a court of record;
- 14 (2) A clerk, prothonotary or deputy prothonotary or deputy
- 15 clerk of a court having a seal;
- 16 (3) A recorder of deeds or deputy recorder of deeds;
- 17 (4) A notary public;
- 18 (5) A justice of the peace, magistrate or alderman[.];

- (6) An attorney who is a member in good standing of the bar 1
- 2 <u>of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.</u>
- Section 2. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar 3
- 4 as they are inconsistent with this act.
- Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 5
