## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing May 19, 1992, as the 115th Anniversary of the  
2 founding of Syria Temple A.A.O.N.M.S.

3 WHEREAS, One hundred and fifteen years ago on May 19, 1877,  
4 Syria Temple A.A.O.N.M.S. was formed and constituted in  
5 Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; and

6 WHEREAS, Throughout its long history, Syria Temple  
7 A.A.O.N.M.S., along with other fraternal organizations, has  
8 strived to help needy, unfortunate and destitute people in the  
9 Pittsburgh area; and

10 WHEREAS, The first Shrine Hospital was founded in 1922. Since  
11 that time, a total of over a half million children have been  
12 treated and returned to a normal life. In 1992 there are 19  
13 orthopedic hospitals and three burn units, and each hospital and  
14 burn unit carries with it the hope, wish and offer to help any  
15 child who needs to be treated, free of charge; therefore be it

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize May 19,

1 1992, as the 115th Anniversary of the founding of Syria Temple  
2 A.A.O.N.M.S. and commend Syria Temple A.A.O.N.M.S. on its good  
3 works and valuable contributions to the people of this  
4 Commonwealth.
