AN ACT

Amending the act of May 13, 1915 (P.L.286, No.177), entitled, as 2 amended, "An act to provide for the health, safety, and 3 welfare of minors: By forbidding their employment or work in certain establishments and occupations, and under certain 4 5 specified ages; by restricting their hours of labor, and 6 regulating certain conditions of their employment; by 7 requiring employment certificates or transferable work 8 permits for certain minors, and prescribing the kinds 9 thereof, and the rules for the issuance, reissuance, filing, return, and recording of the same; by providing that the 10 Industrial Board shall, under certain conditions, determine 11 and declare whether certain occupations are within the 12 13 prohibitions of this act; requiring certain abstracts and 14 notices to be posted; providing for the enforcement of this act by the Secretary of Labor and Industry, the 15 representative of school districts, and police officers; and 16 17 defining the procedure in prosecutions thereunder, and 18 establishing certain presumptions in relation thereto; 19 providing for the issuance of special permits for minors 20 engaging in the entertainment and related fields; providing 21 penalties for the violation of the provisions thereof; and repealing all acts or parts of acts inconsistent therewith," 22 23 reducing minimum age requirements of minors who sell 24 newspapers or merchandise in public places.

- 25 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 26 hereby enacts as follows:
- 27 Section 1. Section 7 of the act of May 13, 1915 (P.L.286,
- 28 No.177), known as the Child Labor Law, amended October 4, 1978

- 1 (P.L.938, No.182), is amended to read:
- 2 Section 7. No minor under [twelve] <u>eleven</u> years of age,
- 3 shall distribute, sell, expose, or offer for sale any newspaper,
- 4 magazine, periodical, or other publication, or any article of
- 5 merchandise of any sort, in any street or public place. No minor
- 6 under fourteen years of age, shall be suffered, employed, or
- 7 permitted to work at any time as a scavenger, bootblack, or in
- 8 any other trade or occupation performed in any street or public
- 9 place. No minor under sixteen years of age, shall engage in any

- 10 occupation mentioned in this section before [six] FIVE o-clock
- 11 in the morning, or after eight o-clock in the evening, of any
- 12 day.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
