AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), entitled "An  
2 act providing for the planning and regulation of solid waste  
3 storage, collection, transportation, processing, treatment,  
4 and disposal; requiring municipalities to submit plans for  
5 municipal waste management systems in their jurisdictions;  
6 authorizing grants to municipalities; providing regulation of  
7 the management of municipal, residual and hazardous waste;  
8 requiring permits for operating hazardous waste and solid  
9 waste storage, processing, treatment, and disposal  
10 facilities; and licenses for transportation of hazardous  
11 waste; imposing duties on persons and municipalities;  
12 granting powers to municipalities; authorizing the  
13 Environmental Quality Board and the Department of  
14 Environmental Resources to adopt rules, regulations,  
15 standards and procedures; granting powers to and imposing  
16 duties upon county health departments; providing remedies;  
17 prescribing penalties; and establishing a fund," further  
18 restricting disposal of hazardous waste.

19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
20 hereby enacts as follows:

21 Section 1. Section 403 of the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380,  
22 No.97), known as the Solid Waste Management Act, is amended by  
23 adding a subsection to read:

24 Section 403. Generation, transportation, storage, treatment and  
25 disposal of hazardous waste.

2       (d) It shall be unlawful for a person to dispose of or to  
3 use as a fuel any hazardous waste listed or identified pursuant  
4 to 25 Pa. Code Ch. 261 (relating to criteria, identification and  
5 listing of hazardous waste) by burning it in a cement kiln. This  
6 prohibition shall not apply to a hazardous waste which is so  
7 designated solely because it exhibits the characteristic of  
8 ignitability.

9       Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
