AN ACT

nding the act of June 30, 1992 (P.L. , No.8A), entitled "An act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of Amending the act of June 30, 1992 (P.L. 2 3 the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the 4 Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for 5 the fiscal year July 1, 1992, to June 30, 1993, for certain institutions and organizations, and for the payment of bills 6 7 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year 8 ending June 30, 1992; to provide appropriations from the 9 State Lottery Fund, the Pennsylvania Economic Revitalization 10 Fund, the Energy Conservation and Assistance Fund, the 11 Hazardous Material Response Fund, The State Stores Fund, the 12 Milk Marketing Fund and the Emergency Medical Services 13 Operating Fund to the Executive Department; to provide 14 appropriations from the Judicial Computer System Augmentation 15 Account to the Judicial Department; to provide appropriations from the Motor License Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 1992, 16 17 to June 30, 1993, for the proper operation of the several 18 departments of the Commonwealth and the Pennsylvania State 19 Police authorized to spend Motor License Fund moneys; to provide for the appropriation of Federal funds to the 20 21 Executive and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth and 22 for the establishment of restricted receipt accounts for the fiscal year July 1, 1992, to June 30, 1993, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close 23 24 25 of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992; to provide for the 26 additional appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive Department of the Commonwealth for the fiscal year July 1, 1991, to June 30, 1992, and for the payment of bills incurred 27 28 29 and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending 30 June 30, 1992, " restoring certain funds relating to the 31 academy for the profession of teaching, for deferred maintenance, for the McKeever Environmental Learning Center 32

- and for rural postsecondary learning; and increasing the
- 2 operating funds of the State System of Higher Education.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. As much as relates to the State System of Higher
- 6 Education, including the Chancellor's Office, the academy for
- 7 the profession of teaching, for deferred maintenance, for the
- 8 McKeever Environmental Learning Center and for rural
- 9 postsecondary learning in section 227 of the act of June 30,
- 10 1992 (P.L. , No.8A), known as the General Appropriation Act
- 11 of 1992, amounts vetoed, are amended to read:
- 12 Section 227. State System of
- 13 Higher Education. -- The following
- 14 amounts are appropriated to the State
- 15 System of Higher Education: Federal State
- 16 For the State System of Higher
- 17 Education, including the Chancellor's
- 18 Office. No funds from this
- 19 appropriation shall be used for the

- 21 maintenance of the property known as
- 22 Welkinweir.
