AN ACT

Amending the act of November 26, 1978 (P.L.1375, No.325), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the regulation 2 3 and safety of dams and reservoirs, water obstructions and encroachments; consolidating and clarifying the programs of 4 5 the Department of Environmental Resources and Navigation Commission for the Delaware River; establishing penalties and 7 repealing certain acts," further providing for general 8 permits. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 11 Section 1. Section 7 of the act of November 26, 1978 12 (P.L.1375, No.325), known as the Dam Safety and Encroachments Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read: 13 14 Section 7. General permits and waiver of permit requirements. 15 (e) A general permit for activity in a wetland is not 16 required where building foundations, other remains of previous 17 18 structures, or existing abandoned structures exist. Building foundations, other remains of previous structures, or existing 19

- 1 abandoned buildings shall constitute evidence that the site was
- 2 previously used for activity other than a wetland. Minor
- 3 <u>hydrological modifications by the owner are not a bar to</u>
- 4 resumption of activities or operations previously conducted at
- 5 the location. The elapsed time between cessation of an operation
- 6 or activity at the site and the planned resumption of activity
- 7 <u>at the site shall not bar the owner for resumption of activity</u>
- 8 at the site. The activity or operations conducted at the site do
- 9 <u>not have to be similar in order to meet the provisions of this</u>
- 10 section. Any discharge of fill material into an adjoining
- 11 wetland in preparation of the site for the resumption of an
- 12 <u>active operation shall not require a permit application as long</u>
- 13 <u>as the discharge is related to the minor hydrological</u>
- 14 modifications which are required to allow the resumption of
- 15 <u>activity at the site.</u>
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
