- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- 3 conviction during parole.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 9774. Conviction during parole.
- 9 Any person who while on parole commits and is convicted of
- 10 any crime in any court of record shall, upon the expiration of
- 11 any sentence of imprisonment for that crime, be compelled by
- 12 <u>detainer and remand as for an escape to complete in the</u>
- 13 correctional facility from which he was paroled the term of
- 14 sentence, without commutation, he would have served had he not
- 15 been released on parole.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
