AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
3 conviction during parole.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 9774. Conviction during parole.

9 Any person who while on parole commits and is convicted of
10 any crime in any court of record shall, upon the expiration of
11 any sentence of imprisonment for that crime, be compelled by
12 detainer and remand as for an escape to complete in the
13 correctional facility from which he was paroled the term of
14 sentence, without commutation, he would have served had he not
15 been released on parole.

16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
