AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for the offense of damaging  
3 leasehold premises and for the offense of absconding without  
4 paying rent due.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
8 Statutes is amended by adding sections to read:

9 § 3310. Damaging leasehold premises.

10 A tenant of residential property who maliciously or wantonly  
11 causes damage to his leasehold premises commits, in addition to  
12 any other offense provided by law, a misdemeanor of the third  
13 degree.

14 § 7509. Absconding without paying rent due.

15 (a) Offense defined.--A tenant of residential property who  
16 intentionally absconds without paying all current or past due  
17 rent commits, in addition to any other offense provided by law,

1 a misdemeanor of the third degree.

2 (b) Applicability.--Subsection (a) shall not apply if any  
3 one of the following conditions are met:

4 (1) The tenant has provided the landlord with a security  
5 deposit which equals or exceeds the amount the tenant owes  
6 the landlord for rent and damage to property.

7 (2) The tenant provides to the landlord in writing a  
8 complete and accurate forwarding address within five days  
9 after the day the tenant vacates the leasehold premises.

10 (3) A civil suit to collect past due rent has been filed  
11 against the tenant or a civil judgment for past due rent has  
12 been entered against the tenant.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
