1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, ~~further providing~~ FURTHER PROVIDING AN EXEMPTION <—
3 FROM CERTAIN FEES AND for certain restrictions on trucks
4 registered in Class 10 or higher AND FOR SPEED TIMING <—
5 DEVICES.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

9 ~~Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:~~

10 SECTION 1. SECTION 1902 OF TITLE 75 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA <—
11 CONSOLIDATED STATUTES IS AMENDED BY ADDING A PARAGRAPH TO READ:
12 § 1902. EXEMPTIONS FROM OTHER FEES.

13 NO FEE SHALL BE CHARGED UNDER THIS TITLE FOR OR TO ANY OF THE
14 FOLLOWING:

16 (8) VOLUNTEER EMERGENCY SERVICE PERSONNEL WHO REQUIRE A
17 CERTIFIED DRIVING RECORD FOR CERTIFICATION UNDER THE ACT OF
18 JULY 3, 1985 (P.L.164, NO.45), KNOWN AS THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL

1 USED BY ANY POLICE OFFICER.

2 (4) NO PERSON MAY BE CONVICTED UPON EVIDENCE OBTAINED
3 THROUGH THE USE OF DEVICES AUTHORIZED BY PARAGRAPHS (2) AND
4 (3) UNLESS THE SPEED RECORDED IS SIX OR MORE MILES PER HOUR
5 IN EXCESS OF THE LEGAL SPEED LIMIT. FURTHERMORE, NO PERSON
6 MAY BE CONVICTED UPON EVIDENCE OBTAINED THROUGH THE USE OF
7 DEVICES AUTHORIZED BY PARAGRAPH (3) IN AN AREA WHERE THE
8 LEGAL SPEED LIMIT IS LESS THAN 55 MILES PER HOUR IF THE SPEED
9 RECORDED IS LESS THAN [TEN] FIVE MILES PER HOUR IN EXCESS OF
10 THE LEGAL SPEED LIMIT. THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL NOT APPLY TO
11 EVIDENCE OBTAINED THROUGH THE USE OF DEVICES AUTHORIZED BY
12 PARAGRAPH (3) WITHIN A SCHOOL ZONE.

14 SECTION 4. SECTION 619-A(1)(I) OF THE ACT OF APRIL 9, 1929
15 (P.L.177, NO.175), KNOWN AS THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF 1929, IS
16 REPEALED INsofar AS IT IS INCONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF 75
17 PA.C.S. § 1902(8).

18 SECTION 5. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AS FOLLOWS:

19 (1) THE AMENDMENT OR ADDITION OF 75 PA.C.S. § 3311 SHALL
20 TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.

21 (2) THE REMAINDER OF THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT
22 IMMEDIATELY.
