## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of 3 murder in the third degree and for attempted criminal 4 homicide. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 2502 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 2502. Murder. 10 (c.1) Vehicle occupant's culpability.--11 12 (1) A person commits murder in the third degree if he is 13 an occupant of a vehicle from which or in which a weapon is intentionally discharged thereby killing a person. 14 15 (2) A person commits attempted criminal homicide if he 16 is an occupant of a vehicle from which or in which a weapon is intentionally discharged with the purpose of injuring 17
