## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, providing for requirements for certificate of junk
- 3 and for securing load of junked vehicles.

- 6 Section 1. Sections 1117 and 4903 of Title 75 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended by adding
- 8 subsections to read:
- 9 § 1117. Vehicle destroyed or junked.

- 11 (a.1) Requirements for certificate of junk.--The department
- 12 shall not issue a certificate of junk to a person until all
- 13 fluids have been drained from the vehicle and any interiors
- 14 containing polychlorinated biphenyls have been removed and
- 15 <u>disposed of in a safe manner.</u>

- 17 § 4903. Securing loads in vehicles.

- (d.1) Load of junked vehicles. -- Every vehicle transporting a 1
- 2 <u>load of junked vehicles shall be enclosed on each side of the</u>
- 3 <u>vehicle</u>, <u>trailer</u> or <u>semitrailer</u> at <u>least</u> as <u>high</u> as the top of
- 4 the load.

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
