AN ACT

- 1 Selecting and designating the square dance as the official 2 American folk dance of this Commonwealth; and selecting and 3 designating the polka as the official ethnic folk dance of 4 this Commonwealth.
- 5 WHEREAS, Square dancing was truly the American dance
- 6 developing in this country as the country itself was progressing
- 7 and moving west; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Though the history of square dancing has gone
- 9 largely unrecorded, it began as it is today a fun folk dance
- 10 whose ancestry can be traced to four principal sources: the
- 11 calling and the timing came from the New England Quadrille, the
- 12 vigor and the fun came from the Kentucky Running Set, several of
- 13 the steps can be traced to Mexico and many figures can be traced
- 14 to European Folk Dances; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Modern square dancing has been a popular form of
- 16 entertainment in this Commonwealth for many years; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Due to the growing popularity of square dancing, a
- 18 State federation was formed to encourage and develop the art of

- 1 square dancing; and
- 2 WHEREAS, There are square dancing federations in every state
- 3 in the nation as well as the District of Columbia, Canada,
- 4 Mexico, Europe and Asia and for the past 37 years these dancing
- 5 enthusiasts have joined together during the National Square
- 6 Dance Convention; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Square dancing has become extremely popular with the
- 8 citizens of this Commonwealth; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The polka dance, which originated in Bohemia and
- 10 swept across Europe and the Americas, became an extremely
- 11 popular ethnic folk dance throughout this Commonwealth; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The polka has remained the most popular ethnic folk
- 13 dance of all ethnic dances that are performed in this
- 14 Commonwealth; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The polka as an ethnic folk dance is likely to
- 16 continue as the most popular ethnic folk dance in this
- 17 Commonwealth for many years into the future.
- 18 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 19 hereby enacts as follows:
- 20 Section 1. Square dancing is hereby selected, designated and
- 21 adopted as the official folk dance of this Commonwealth of
- 22 Pennsylvania.
- 23 Section 2. The polka is hereby selected, designated and
- 24 adopted as the official ethnic folk dance of this Commonwealth.
- 25 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
