AN ACT

Making appropriations to the Thomas Jefferson University, Philadelphia.
The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. (a) The sum of \$5,869,000 is hereby appropriated
to the Thomas Jefferson University, Philadelphia, for the fiscal
year July 1, 1994, to June 30, 1995, for instruction in the

8 Doctor of Medicine program.

9 (b) The sum of \$4,113,000 is hereby appropriated to the 10 Thomas Jefferson University, Philadelphia, for the fiscal year July 1, 1994, to June 30, 1995, for the general maintenance of 11 the Thomas Jefferson University, including the College of Allied 12 13 Health Sciences, student aid and Children's Heart Hospital. 14 Section 2. Payments to the Thomas Jefferson University on 15 account of the appropriations provided in section 1 shall be 16 made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the basis of 17 costs during the fiscal year.

1 Section 3. The Thomas Jefferson University shall provide 2 full, complete and accurate information as may be required by 3 the Department of Education or the chairman or the minority 4 chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the 5 chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations 6 Committee of the House of Representatives.

7 Section 4. The Thomas Jefferson University shall report its 8 revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and 9 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the 10 "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth 11 of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of 12 13 Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-Related Colleges and Universities." 14

15 Section 5. The trustees of the Thomas Jefferson University 16 shall report on forms provided by the Department of Education to 17 both the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations 18 Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority chairman 19 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives 20 by September 30, 1995, on how State-appropriated funds were expended for fiscal year 1994-1995 to reduce the costs to 21 22 Pennsylvania resident students or to provide services to 23 Pennsylvania residents.

24 Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1994, or 25 immediately, whichever is later.
