AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 5, 1968 (P.L.140, No.78), entitled "An  
2 act regulating the writing, cancellation of or refusal to  
3 renew policies of automobile insurance; and imposing powers  
4 and duties on the Insurance Commissioner therefor," further  
5 providing for cancellation or refusal to write or renew  
6 automobile insurance.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 3(a) of the act of June 5, 1968 (P.L.140,  
10 No.78), entitled "An act regulating the writing, cancellation of  
11 or refusal to renew policies of automobile insurance; and  
12 imposing powers and duties on the Insurance Commissioner  
13 therefor," is amended by adding a clause to read:

14 Section 3. (a) No insurer shall cancel or refuse to write  
15 or renew a policy of automobile insurance for one or more of the  
16 following reasons:

18 (15) Inability to verify a driving record due to the recent  
19 relocation of the driver into this Commonwealth.

2       Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
