- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section X of the act of May 28, 1715 (1 Sm.L.94,
- 7 Ch.208), entitled "An act for acknowledging and recording of
- 8 deeds, amended July 31, 1968 (P.L.866, No.259), is amended to
- 9 read:
- 10 X. And if such mortgagee, by himself or his attorney, shall
- 11 not, within forty-five days after request and tender made for
- 12 his reasonable charges, return to the said office, and there
- 13 make such acknowledgment as aforesaid, he, she or they,
- 14 neglecting so to do, shall for every such offense, forfeit and
- 15 pay[, unto the party or parties aggrieved, any sum not exceeding
- 16 the mortgage-money, to be recovered in any Court of Record
- 17 within this Commonwealth, by bill, complaint or information.]

- three hundred dollars to the mortgagor. Following the forty-five 1
- 2 <u>day period</u>, if the amount forfeited is not paid within ten
- 3 <u>business days after demand for payment, the mortgagee shall pay</u>
- 4 any court costs and reasonable attorney fees incurred by the

- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
