AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of December 22, 1983 (P.L.327, No.85), entitled 2 "An act imposing regulations and licensing requirements on 3 auctioneers, apprentice auctioneers, auction houses and
- 4 auction companies; imposing powers and duties on the State
- Board of Auctioneer Examiners; and making repeals, "further
- 6 providing for reciprocity with other states.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 12 of the act of December 22, 1983
- 10 (P.L.327, No.85), known as the Auctioneer and Auction Licensing
- 11 Act, is amended to read:
- 12 Section 12. Reciprocity with other states.
- 13 (a) General rule.--A [nonresident of] person domiciled in
- 14 this Commonwealth who applies for a license as an auctioneer or
- 15 apprentice auctioneer may be granted a license for which he
- 16 applies if he is licensed as an auctioneer or apprentice
- 17 auctioneer by the proper authority of [the state of his
- 18 domicile] another state, upon the payment by the applicant of
- 19 the proper license fee and the filing with the board of a

- 1 properly certified copy of the license issued to the applicant
- 2 by [the state of his domicile, subject to the following
- 3 limitations:
- 4 (1) The auctioneer licensing laws of the nonresident
- 5 state must extend to licensed auctioneers and apprentice
- 6 auctioneers of this Commonwealth the same rights and
- 7 privileges and the same authority to conduct auction sales in
- 8 that state as this act extends to nonresidents of this
- 9 Commonwealth without the necessity of the licensed
- 10 auctioneers and apprentice auctioneers of this Commonwealth
- 11 to obtain additional or further licenses or authority from
- any political subdivision of that state to conduct an auction
- 13 sale.
- 14 (2) The nonresident auctioneer or apprentice auctioneer
- is only permitted to sell at auction in this Commonwealth
- 16 whatever property the laws of his state permit nonresident
- auctioneers and apprentice auctioneers to sell at auction.]
- 18 that state. This reciprocity shall apply only if the other state
- 19 grants similar reciprocity to the auctioneers and apprentice
- 20 auctioneers licensed by this Commonwealth.
- 21 (b) Bond.--The bond required by this act shall accompany the
- 22 application.
- 23 [(c) Change of nonresident status.--The movement from
- 24 another state or jurisdiction to domicile in this Commonwealth
- 25 eliminates the possibility of reciprocal licensing set forth in
- 26 this section and the individual must qualify for a license under
- 27 terms of this act which are applicable to residents of this
- 28 Commonwealth.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
