A RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing Congress to not ratify the North American Free
2 Trade Agreement.

3 WHEREAS, Approximately 500,000 American jobs have been lost
4 to Mexico in the past ten years due to the lack of collective
5 bargaining and weaker regulation of health, safety and the
6 environment; and

7 WHEREAS, The North American Free Trade Agreement will
8 establish an imbalance of trade and inequities for American
9 business, labor and commerce; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize
11 Congress to not ratify the North American Free Trade Agreement;
12 and be it further

13 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
14 the presiding officers of each house of Congress and to each
15 member of Congress from Pennsylvania.
