A RESOLUTION

1 Saluting the Philadelphia Commission on Human Relations and
2 individuals who have contributed to intergroup harmony and
3 understanding.

4 WHEREAS, This Nation was founded on the principles of a
5 democratic self-government, independence and religious freedom.
6 A free and tolerant society was envisioned, one offering
7 harmony, opportunity and understanding to those who had long
8 been persecuted; and

9 WHEREAS, Philadelphia is observing Human Relations Month to
10 increase public awareness of laws prohibiting discrimination and
11 to promote intergroup harmony and understanding among
12 communities; and

13 WHEREAS, The Philadelphia Commission on Human Relations is
14 gathering on October 26, 1993, to convene its Annual Human
15 Rights Awards Luncheon to publicly recognize and thank
16 individuals who have made outstanding contributions in promoting
17 intergroup harmony and understanding; therefore be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives salute the

1 Philadelphia Commission on Human Relations and the individuals
2 it is honoring; and be it further

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all citizens
4 to emulate the good deeds of the honorees and make good human
5 relations a part of everyone's daily life.
