## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring General George A. Joulwan on his appointment as the top  
2 United States commander in Europe and the head of the North  
3 Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO).

4 WHEREAS, On October 4, 1993, President Clinton appointed  
5 General George A. Joulwan, a native of Pottsville, to be the top  
6 United States commander in Europe and head of the North Atlantic  
7 Treaty Organization (NATO); and

8 WHEREAS, General Joulwan's appointment was quickly confirmed  
9 by the Senate; and

10 WHEREAS, General Joulwan replaces General John M.  
11 Shalikashvili as Supreme Allied Commander Europe and Commander  
12 in Chief, United States European Command; and

13 WHEREAS, General Joulwan, an infantryman by training, served  
14 as commander of the Army's 3rd Armored Division in Germany in  
15 1988 and 1989 and then became commander of V Corps in Europe. He  
16 has also been chief of staff at the 3rd Infantry Division in  
17 Europe and was deputy chief of staff for operations for the  
18 United States Seventh Army in Europe. Since November 1990

1 General Joulwan has commanded United States forces in Latin  
2 America; and

3 WHEREAS, General Joulwan is a 1961 graduate of the United  
4 States Military Academy, West Point, and a 1957 graduate of  
5 Pottsville High School where he was a standout offensive lineman  
6 on the football team, making the Big 33 all state team in 1956;  
7 and

8 WHEREAS, General Joulwan served five years in Germany after  
9 his West Point graduation and then served two combat tours in  
10 Vietnam where he won the Vietnam Cross of Gallantry. He also  
11 received two silver stars, the Legion of Merit and three bronze  
12 stars; therefore be it

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor General  
14 George A. Joulwan on his appointment as the top United States  
15 commander in Europe and the head of NATO and commend his  
16 distinguished career and accomplishments.
