## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Directing the Speaker of the House to appoint a committee to
- investigate the high charge for pumped gasoline and recommend
- 3 appropriate remedies.
- 4 WHEREAS, Most persons having disabilities are unable to pump
- 5 gasoline into their vehicles and are required to purchase
- 6 gasoline pumped by station attendants; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Pumped gasoline is considerably higher in price than
- 8 gasoline pumped by the purchaser, sometimes as much as 60¢ more
- 9 per gallon; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the Speaker of the House appoint a five-member
- 11 committee to hold hearings on the extreme disparity between the
- 12 price of purchaser-pumped and attendant-pumped gasoline and to
- 13 make recommendations to the House of Representatives regarding a
- 14 solution to this problem for citizens of this Commonwealth who
- 15 have disabilities.
