LO	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
L1	hereby enacts as follows:	
L2	Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be	<
L3	necessary, are hereby appropriated to the Trustees of the	
L4	University of Pennsylvania for the fiscal year July 1, 1992, to	
L5	June 30, 1993, for the purposes and in the amounts as shown:	
L6	(1) For instruction, excluding Veterinary	
L7	Medicine programs and Doctor of Medicine \$16,051,000	
L8	(2) For dental clinics	
L9	(3) For instruction in the Doctor of Medicine

1	(4) For instruction in Veterinary Medicine	
2	programs only	
3	(5) For the New Bolton Animal Center 3,787,000	
4	(6) For the Center for Animal Health and

6	(7) For food and animal clinics and services 2,039,000	
7	Section 2. Payments to the University of Pennsylvania on	
8	account of the appropriations for the items provided in section	
9	1 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the	
10	basis of costs during the fiscal year.	
11	Section 3. The University of Pennsylvania shall provide	
12	full, complete and accurate information as may be required by	
13	the Department of Education or the majority chairman or the	
14	minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate	
15	or the majority chairman or the minority chairman of the	
16	Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.	
17	Section 4. The University of Pennsylvania shall report its	
18	revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements	
19	in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and	
20	procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the	
21	"Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth	
22	of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of	
23	Higher Education, State Related Universities and Non State	
24	Related Colleges and Universities."	
25	Section 5. This act shall take effect immediately.

- 4 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS; DECLARATION OF POLICY.
- 5 IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND DECLARED AS A MATTER OF
- 6 LEGISLATIVE FINDING:
- 7 (1) THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA HAS A RICH HERITAGE
- 8 OF HISTORICAL BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES, DOCUMENTS, ARTIFACTS AND
- 9 OTHER OBJECTS AND RESOURCES WHICH BEAR WITNESS TO ITS GROWTH
- 10 AS ONE OF THE GREAT STATES OF THIS NATION.
- 11 (2) EFFORTS HAVE BEEN MADE TOWARD THE RESTORATION AND
- 12 PRESERVATION OF BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES, DOCUMENTS, ARTIFACTS
- 13 AND OBJECTS EVIDENCING THE HISTORY OF THIS EMINENT
- 14 COMMONWEALTH AND OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND THESE EFFORTS
- 15 SHOULD BE CONTINUED AND INTENSIFIED.
- 16 (3) PARTICULAR ATTENTION SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THE
- 17 PRESERVATION OF THE ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL INTEGRITY OF
- 18 THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND THE CAPITOL ANNEX AND TO THE
- 19 RESTORATION AND PRESERVATION OF ARTIFACTS, DOCUMENTS AND
- 20 OTHER HISTORICAL OBJECTS AND RESOURCES LOCATED WITHIN THAT
- 21 BUILDING.
- 22 (4) THE MOST EFFECTIVE WAY TO PROMOTE AND FOSTER THE
- 23 HISTORIC PRESERVATION OF THE STATE CAPITOL [BUILDING] COMPLEX
- 24 IS BY THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMMITTEE TO SUPERVISE AND
- 25 COORDINATE THIS WORK.
- 26 SECTION 2. SECTION 6 OF THE ACT, AMENDED JUNE 21, 1984
- 27 (P.L.425, NO.85), IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 28 SECTION 6. CAPITOL RESTORATION TRUST FUND AND OPERATING
- EXPENSES.
- 30 (A) ESTABLISHMENT AND ADMINISTRATION.--THERE IS HEREBY

- 1 ESTABLISHED A SEPARATE FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY TO BE KNOWN AS
- 2 THE CAPITOL RESTORATION TRUST FUND. THIS FUND SHALL BE
- 3 ADMINISTERED BY THE COMMITTEE AND ALL MONEYS IN THE FUND ARE
- 4 HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE COMMITTEE ON A CONTINUING BASIS.
- 5 (B) PURPOSE.--THE MONEYS IN THE FUND SHALL BE USED:
- 6 (1) FOR THE MAINTENANCE, RESTORATION, PRESERVATION AND
- 7 REHABILITATION OF ARTIFACTS, DOCUMENTS AND OTHER HISTORICAL
- 8 OBJECTS OR RESOURCES LOCATED WITHIN AND AROUND OR ASSOCIATED
- 9 WITH THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDING OR ACQUIRED BY THE COMMITTEE;

- 11 (2) FOR THE ACQUISITION OF ARTIFACTS, DOCUMENTS AND
- 12 OTHER HISTORICAL OBJECTS OR RESOURCES, INCLUDING BUT NOT
- 13 LIMITED TO, STATUARY, ART OR ANY ELEMENT WHICH CONTRIBUTE TO
- 14 THE HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCY OF THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDING[.];

- 16 (3) FOR THE RESTORATION AND RENOVATION OF THE CAPITOL

- 18 (C) CONTRIBUTIONS, SOLICITATION OF FUNDS.--
- 19 (1) THE COMMITTEE IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED:
- 20 (I) TO ACCEPT ON BEHALF OF THE COMMONWEALTH GIFTS,
- DONATIONS, LEGACIES AND USAGES OF MONEY FROM INDIVIDUALS,
- 22 ORGANIZATIONS, PUBLIC OR PRIVATE CORPORATIONS AND OTHER
- 23 SIMILAR ENTITIES; [AND]
- 24 (II) TO SOLICIT AND RAISE MONEYS FROM PUBLIC AND
- 25 PRIVATE SOURCES THROUGH THE SALE OF COMMEMORATIVE MEDALS
- 26 AND OTHER ITEMS OF A SIMILAR NATURE WHICH PROMOTE THE
- 27 HISTORIC PRESERVATION AND RESTORATION OF THE STATE
- 28 CAPITOL BUILDING[.]; AND
- 29 <u>(III) TO IMPLEMENT THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS UNDER</u>
- 30 <u>PARAGRAPH</u> (3).

- 1 (2) EXCEPT FOR APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE GENERAL
- 2 ASSEMBLY, ALL MONEYS RECEIVED OR RAISED UNDER THIS SECTION
- 3 SHALL BE PAID INTO THE STATE TREASURY AND CREDITED TO THE
- 4 CAPITOL RESTORATION TRUST FUND.
- 5 (3) ALL MONEYS APPROPRIATED TO BUT NOT EXPENDED BY THE
- DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES FOR THE RESTORATION AND 6
- 7 RENOVATION OF THE CAPITOL ANNEX, PLUS ACCRUED INTEREST, ARE
- 8 TRANSFERRED INTO THE FUND.
- 9 (D) OPERATING EXPENSES. -- APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE GENERAL
- ASSEMBLY TO THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE USED FOR PAYMENT OF NECESSARY 10
- 11 TRAVEL AND OTHER REASONABLE EXPENSES OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS, FOR
- 12 THE COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES OF STAFF FOR THE COMMITTEE, FOR
- 13 ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES AND GENERALLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF
- 14 CARRYING INTO EFFECT THE PROVISIONS OF THE ACT.
- 15 SECTION 3. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
