Section 6114(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 6 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding paragraphs to read: § 6114. Limitation on sale, publication and disclosure of 8 9 records. 10 11 (b) Exceptions. -- This section does not apply to records or 12 reports: 13 14 (4.1) Of a constituent released to a member of Congress 15 or of the General Assembly or to an employee of a member of Congress or of the General Assembly. Under this paragraph, 16 records or reports may not be sold, published or disclosed by 17

the member or the employee for any commercial purpose without

- 3 (6) Obtained in any form, including computer access, by
- 4 <u>a messenger service which has filed an affidavit of intended</u>
- 5 <u>use with the department and which maintains on file at its</u>

- 8 <u>authorizations are subject to inspection by the department</u>
- 9 and shall be retained for a period of two years. The records
- or reports may not be accessed, sold, published or disclosed
- by the messenger service for any commercial purpose except
- the filed intended use without prior approval by the
- department.
