AN ACT

1 Making appropriations to the Thomas Jefferson University,  
2 Philadelphia.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. (a) The sum of \$6,082,000 is hereby appropriated  
6 to the Thomas Jefferson University, Philadelphia, for the fiscal  
7 year July 1, 1993, to June 30, 1994, for instruction in the  
8 Doctor of Medicine program.

9 (b) The sum of \$4,262,000 is hereby appropriated to the  
10 Thomas Jefferson University, Philadelphia, for the fiscal year  
11 July 1, 1993, to June 30, 1994, for the general maintenance of  
12 the Thomas Jefferson University, including the College of Allied  
13 Health Sciences, student aid and Children's Heart Hospital.

14 Section 2. Payments to the Thomas Jefferson University on  
15 account of the appropriations provided in section 1 shall be  
16 made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the basis of  
17 costs during the fiscal year.

1       Section 3. The Thomas Jefferson University shall provide  
2 full, complete and accurate information as may be required by  
3 the Department of Education or the majority chairman or the  
4 minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate  
5 or the majority chairman or the minority chairman of the  
6 Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.

7       Section 4. The Thomas Jefferson University shall report its  
8 revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements  
9 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and  
10 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the  
11 "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth  
12 of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of  
13 Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-  
14 Related Colleges and Universities."

15       Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1993, or  
16 immediately, whichever is later.
