- 15 which provides telecommunication service. The term includes, but
- 16 is not limited to, a cellular, paging or other wireless
- 17 communications company or other person or entity which, for a
- 18 fee, supplies the facility, cell site, mobile telephone
- 19 switching office or other equipment or telecommunication
- 20 service.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
