2	C.1. Prior to repossessing a motor vehicle which is located
3	on the premises of or in proximity to a repair garage or body or
4	paint shop, or is otherwise not in the possession of the owner
5	of the vehicle, the repossessor shall notify in writing the
6	owner or manager of the repair garage or body or paint shop, or
7	the other person reasonably believed to be in possession of the
8	vehicle, that the vehicle is being repossessed.
