AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for purchase, 2 consumption, possession or transportation of alcohol by 4 certain persons and for possession of false identification to 5 obtain alcohol. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Sections 6308(b) and 6310.3(b) of Title 18 of the 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 9 10 § 6308. Purchase, consumption, possession or transportation of 11 liquor or malt or brewed beverages. 12 13 (b) [Penalty] Minimum penalty. -- In addition to the penalty imposed pursuant to section 6310.4 (relating to restriction of 14 15 operating privileges), a person convicted of violating 16 subsection (a) [may] shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$500 [for the second and each subsequent violation]. 17

There shall be no authority in any court to impose on an

offender any lesser sentence than the minimum sentence mandated

- 6 (b) Minimum penalty.--In addition to any other penalty
- 7 imposed pursuant to section 6310.4 (relating to restriction of

- 9 convicted of violating subsection (a) shall be sentenced to pay
- 10 a fine of not more than \$500 [for the second and subsequent

- 14 Section 2. The amendment of 18 Pa.C.S. §§ 6308(b) and
- 15 6310.3(b) shall apply to sentences imposed on or after the
