AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled
- 2 "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth,
- 3 sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising,
- 4 consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto,"
- 5 further providing for assistant county solicitors.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 904 of the act of August 9, 1955
- 9 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, amended December
- 10 22, 1981 (P.L.524, No.147), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 904. Assistant County Solicitors.--The county
- 12 commissioners may appoint [not more than three] assistant county
- 13 solicitors, [and, with the approval of the court of common
- 14 pleas, special counsel] who shall be attorneys at law admitted
- 15 to practice in the courts of this Commonwealth[.], in such
- 16 numbers and at such salaries as shall be fixed by the salary
- 17 board. At the request of the county solicitor, the county
- 18 commissioners may retain special counsel for particular
- 19 proceedings or where special expertise is needed. Each assistant

- 1 <u>county solicitor</u> and special counsel shall perform such duties
- 2 in connection with the legal affairs of the county as may be
- 3 assigned to him by the county commissioners or the county
- 4 solicitor.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
