12	appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to

16	and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth,
17	authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes
18	to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of
19	section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of
20	Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of

22 23	department, board, commission, and officer of the State
23 24	government, every political subdivision of the State, and certain officers of such subdivisions, every person,

25 26	collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws

32 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

1 hereby enacts as follows:

2 Section 1. Section 1616.1-B(b) of the act of April 9, 1929 3 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, amended June 28, 1993 (P.L.183, No.39), is amended to read: 4 5 Section 1616.1-B. Appropriation and Limitation on Redevelopment Assistance Capital Projects. --* * * 6 7 (b) The maximum amount of redevelopment assistance capital 8 projects undertaken by the Commonwealth for which obligations are to be issued shall not exceed, in aggregate, [seven hundred 9 million dollars (\$700,000,000)] nine hundred million dollars 10 (\$900,000,000). 11

12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
