## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, providing for the initial dates of
- 3 legislative sessions.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 4 of Article II be amended to read:
- 9 § 4. Sessions.
- 10 The General Assembly shall be a continuing body during the
- 11 term for which its Representatives are elected. It shall meet at
- 12 12 o'clock noon on the first Monday after the first Tuesday of
- 13 January each year. Special sessions shall be called by the
- 14 Governor on petition of a majority of the members elected to
- 15 each House or may be called by the Governor whenever in his
- 16 opinion the public interest requires.

- 1 Section 2. This proposed amendment shall be submitted by the
- 2 Secretary of the Commonwealth to the qualified electors of this
- 3 Commonwealth at the primary, general or municipal election next
- 4 held after the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 5 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania have been satisfied.
