AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 18, 1974 (P.L.359, No.120), entitled "An act creating the Municipal Police Officers' Education and 3 Training Commission; providing for the commission's membership, selection, compensation, and removal; providing for the powers and duties of the commission; providing for the appointment and duties of the chairman; providing for the 7 act's applicability to the civil service laws; requiring training by certain political subdivisions and police 9 departments; providing penalties for violation thereof; and making an appropriation, providing for mandatory and uniform 10 photo identification cards for all certified municipal police 11 12 officers.
- 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 14 hereby enacts as follows:
- 15 Section 1. Section 2(8) of the act of June 18, 1974
- 16 (P.L.359, No.120), referred to as the Municipal Police Education
- 17 and Training Law, amended June 28, 1993 (P.L.174, No.35), is
- 18 amended to read:
- 19 Section 2. Definitions.--As used in this act:
- 20 * * *

- 1 (8) "Certification" means the assignment of a certification
- 2 number and certification photo identification card bearing that
- 3 <u>number</u> to a police officer after successful completion of a
- 4 mandatory basic training course or receipt of a waiver of basic
- 5 training from the commission and successful completion of
- 6 mandatory in-service training. Certification is for a period of
- 7 two years. New photo identification cards shall be issued with
- 8 each recertification.
- 9 Section 2. Section 5(13) of the act, amended December 21,
- 10 1988 (P.L.1865, No.180), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 5. Powers and Duties of the Commission. -- The powers
- 12 and duties of the commission shall be as follows:
- 13 * * *
- 14 (13) To certify police officers who have satisfactorily
- 15 completed basic educational and training requirements as
- 16 established by the commission and to issue appropriate
- 17 certificates and photo identification cards to such police
- 18 officers. The production of municipal police officer
- 19 <u>certification cards shall be the responsibility of the</u>
- 20 <u>commission</u>. The certification shall be designed to carry a photo
- 21 <u>image of the officer and shall be processed at no charge to the</u>
- 22 officer. The commission shall contract with vendors responsible
- 23 for storing photo images for the Department of Transportation to
- 24 produce the municipal police officers' photo identification
- 25 <u>cards. The images collected for the purpose of producing photo</u>
- 26 <u>drivers' licenses shall be made available to the commission for</u>
- 27 its sole purpose of producing police identification cards. The
- 28 word "Police" and the photo shall be given primary placement on
- 29 the card to make recognition of the officer as a certified
- 30 police officer apparent. Other identifying information shall

- include, but not be limited to, department name and 1
- 2 <u>certification expiration date</u>. All <u>certified municipal police</u>
- 3 <u>officers shall carry the municipal police officer certification</u>
- 4 <u>card and shall use the municipal police officer certification</u>
- card as the primary form of identification along with the badge. 5
- 6 * * *
- 7 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
