## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for reporting of suspected 3 abuse or a prohibited sexual act. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 6312 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 6312. Sexual abuse of children. 9 (b.1) Reporting of suspected abuse or a prohibited sexual 10 11 <u>act.--</u> (1) Any commercial film or photographic print processor 12 13 who: (i) discovers evidence of suspected sexual abuse of 14 a minor as defined under 23 Pa.C.S. § 6302 (relating to 15 findings and purpose of chapter) or suspected prohibited 16

1	sexual acts involving a minor; and
2	(ii) fails to report the same to the Pennsylvania
3	State Police commits a summary offense and shall be
4	sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$50 for a first
5	offense and not less than \$150 for subsequent offenses.
6	(2) Any employer who employs commercial film or
7	photographic print processors and who fails to inform such
8	employees of their required reporting under this subsection
9	commits a summary offense and shall be sentenced to pay a
10	fine of not less than \$300.

12	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
