AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for legislative plates.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Sections 1339 and 4524(b) of Title 75 of the
- 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 7 § 1339. Legislative plate.
- 8 Upon application by a member of the General Assembly of the
- 9 Commonwealth or the Congress of the United States, the
- 10 department shall issue special registration plates indicating
- 11 that the vehicle is owned by a member of the Pennsylvania or
- 12 United States Senate or House of Representatives, as
- 13 appropriate. Upon expiration of a legislative plate and issuance
- 14 of a personal plate, the member may display the legislative
- 15 plate in the left corner of the rear window of the vehicle,
- 16 provided he remains a member of the Pennsylvania or United
- 17 States Senate or House of Representatives, as appropriate.

- 1 § 4524. Windshield obstructions and wipers.
- 2 * * *
- 3 (b) Obstruction on side and rear windows. -- No person shall
- 4 drive any motor vehicle with any sign, poster or other
- 5 nontransparent material, including ice or snow, upon the side
- 6 wings or side or rear windows of the vehicle which materially
- 7 obstructs, obscures or impairs the driver's clear view of the
- 8 highway or any intersecting highway[.], except for legislative
- 9 plates provided for in section 1339 (relating to legislative
- 10 plate).

- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
