## A RESOLUTION

1 Proclaiming the week of April 22 through 27, 1996, as "Lions  
2 Sight and Hearing Conservation Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The more than 35,000 Lions in this Commonwealth are  
4 actively engaged in sight and hearing conservation, aid to  
5 persons who are blind and persons who are deaf and programs  
6 urging our citizens to take care of the precious gifts of sight  
7 and hearing; and

8 WHEREAS, The Candy Day drive for funds helps to provide funds  
9 for the Lions for their eye and hearing research, helps to pay  
10 for eye examinations, helps to buy glasses for people in need,  
11 helps to pay costs of needed eye surgery, helps to purchase

1 hearing aids for needy people and helps to maintain the Lions  
2 Eye Banks which have provided corneal transplants for thousands  
3 of people and has given them, once again, the precious gift of  
4 sight; therefore be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives proclaim the week  
6 of April 22 through 27, 1996, as "Lions Sight and Hearing  
7 Conservation Week" in Pennsylvania to be climaxed on April 26  
8 and 27, 1996, with Lions Candy Day; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all citizens  
10 to be generous to their neighbors, helpful to the Lions because  
11 they provide these great humanitarian services for the citizens  
12 of this Commonwealth and generous with gifts to the Lions for  
13 their great work.
