A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Jim Leyland for his 11 years as manager of the
2 Pittsburgh Pirates.

3 WHEREAS, Jim Leyland was named manager of the Pittsburgh
4 Pirates on November 20, 1985; and

5 WHEREAS, Jim Leyland inherited a last-place team and in 1990
6 was able to win his first of three consecutive division titles;

8 WHEREAS, Jim Leyland was named the Manager of the Year in
9 1988, 1990 and 1992 and established himself as one of the best
10 managers in baseball; and

11 WHEREAS, In club history, only two other managers have
12 skipped the Pirates longer than Jim Leyland; and

13 WHEREAS, With 850 career managerial victories, Jim Leyland
14 ranks third in club history and fifth among active managers; and

1 WHEREAS, Jim Leyland gave more than just his superb managing
2 abilities to the Pittsburgh Pirates, the City of Pittsburgh and
3 all Pirates' fans, giving his heart as well; therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate Jim
5 Leyland's 11 seasons as the manager of the Pittsburgh Pirates.
