AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, further providing for special plates for survivors
- of certain individuals killed in the line of duty.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 1358. Special plates for survivors of certain individuals
- 9 killed in the line of duty.
- 10 Upon application of any person who is a spouse, child or
- 11 dependent of a person who died in the line of duty while serving
- 12 as a firefighter, first-aid or rescue squad member, emergency
- 13 medical technician, police officer, National Guardsman or United
- 14 States Armed Forces member, accompanied by a fee of \$20, which
- 15 shall be in addition to the annual registration fee, and by such
- 16 documentation as the department shall require, the department
- 17 shall issue a special registration plate designating the vehicle
- 18 as belonging to a person who is a survivor of a person killed in

- 1 the line of duty. The special registration plate may be used
- 2 only on passenger vehicles and other vehicles with a registered
- 3 gross weight of not more than 9,000 pounds.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
